Of course this unforeseen fury of Mother nature along with unexpected Harthals forced us to curtail some of the activities planned according to the Annual Curriculum Planner planned well before the commencing of the year.

Students, teachers and other staff members of our school together contributed an amount of Rs.54495 to Chief Minister's relief fund.

The five year's growth and development of our school is incredible. We are proud to build up a positive work culture in our school. Students' evaluation is continuous and comprehensive in nature. Reading skill has been enhanced inexplicably in almost all students of our school.

For the pupils, the most important thing about school wide events is their social significance and atmosphere.

World Environment day was celebrated in our school on 5th June 2018 based on the theme "Beat Plastic Pollution". Students with their class teachers planted a tree near the school.

Iron Man of India's freedom struggle, Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel, lent his steely strength to India's consolidation after Independence, in full measure. A new nation was born. The challenge of protecting its unity was evident. On 31st October, therefore, the nation celebrates his birth anniversary as Rashtriya Ekta Diwas, rejoicing over his precious legacy.

Rastriya Ekta Divas was organized in our school on 31st October 2018. A "Run for Unity" was organized at Kotta Maidanam Palakkad. A message of national unity was permeated through this activity. Principal administered a special pledge on National Integrity.

National Postal week was celebrated during the week 9-15 October 2018. Many students from our school participated in the letter writing contest on the theme, "A letter to my Mother Land". It was very easy for our children to write a letter to Mother land, as they have portrayed the worries, concern, agonies, achievement and expectation through our second annual function Sparsham - 2 , Sparsham of Motherland.

The central vigilance commission, an apex integrity institution of the country, in its endeavor to promote transparency, accountability and integrity in public life has been declaring observance of vigilance awareness week every year to encourage the fight against corruption. In this view, our school has conducted our 5th Annual Exhibition Spandanam-5 as Spandanam of Paryatanam on 24.11.2018 Through this exhibition, our students exhibited a live demonstration on the scope of environmentally sustainable tourism of our own state, Kerala. The exhibition focused on the seven areas of environmentally sustainable tourism like Festival tourism, Heritage Tourism, Health tourism, Beach tourism, Backwater tourism, Sports tourism and rural tourism.

Sports competitions inculcate the spirit of positive challenges and sportsmanship among the students and prepare them for the life ahead. Sports, Games and physical fitness occupy a place of importance in our curriculum. Our annual sports day - Gladden Gambol -5 was conducted on 23.01.2019. Mr. Rajesh, SI of North Police station graced the occasion as chief guest. Students actively participated in different events and won medals and certificates. Special flat races were organized for parents and teachers too....

One of the major advantages of project work is that it makes school, more like real life. It is an in-depth investigation of a real-world topic worthy of children's attention and effort.

Through research-based learning students can develop the intellectual skills of critical analysis and also valuable transferable skills such as group work, time and resource management and data handling.

A project based on research on the topic on disaster management was given to students of grades 3 to 10. The students were inspired to do a research on causes and consequences of the flood, our state had to face at the apex of monsoon 2018. Some of the research thesis submitted by students were really stupendous.

A class magazine has been prepared by the students at class level. The effort, creativity and team work of each and every class was praiseworthy.

Bhasha sangam, an initiative of Ministry of Human Resources Development, Dept. of School Education and Literacy, Govt. of India under Ek Bharath Shresht Bharat Programme is meant for schools and educational institutions to provide multilingual exposure to students in Indian Languages listed in Schedule VIII of the constitution of India. Through this we provided a simple but effective learning opportunity to our children to enhance linguistic tolerance and respect, and promote national integration. Five sentences pertaining to the language of the day, one among the 22 languages mentioned in section 8 of constitution of India, were read out in the morning assembly daily from 20.11 to 21.12.2018. Children were inspired to greet each other in the Indian language they have learnt on the particular day. Students learnt to greet each other by saying...Namaskaram, Namste, adaab, Vanakkam, sat shri akaal, asalamu alaikum,namo namaha, johar, nomoshkaar etc.

The library occupies a very important place in school. With its books suited to the interests and aptitudes of students of different age groups, with its magazines, periodicals, newspapers and with its calm and tranquil atmosphere it has a special call to students who go there and quench their thirst for reading the material which cannot be provided to them in the classroom. Our library has more than 8000 titles out of which 3000 books are reserved for primary classes. At TEPS, children from Grade 1 onwards utilize the library by reading at least one book per week.

Reading develops a child's imagination and creativity and is a great approach to support your child to dream.

Reading habit in students was nurtured by introducing SMART READER award every month at class level. The smart reader of the year was selected by the child's utilization of library by reading maximum number of books in a year.
